Dear Families

We are delighted to let you know that from September 2023, students will be completing their Science homework on the online learning platform Seneca. Science homework will be set each week and students will have one week to complete the tasks.

The homework will be based on content from previous topics so that students can keep practising the skills they have learned. The questions are designed to be achievable whilst offering the stretch that learners need to make progress.

How to complete Seneca

Students will be provided with a class code which allows them to join their teachers class. They will then be set one assignment every week. Teachers will show students in class how to log in and use the site. Some classes may occasionally be set extra paper homework relevant to the topic they are currently learning. Their teacher will direct the students to record this in their planners.

Support

Seneca provides some information for students to read that supports them to learn the answers to the questions. Students can make notes to write down the key words to help them on questions they are getting wrong, and to record the correct spellings.

Computer access

Students can complete their homework on phones or devices at home or computers in the Learning Bubble homework club any afternoon after school. There will also be members of staff available to support students further if they need it.

100% completion

Homework is not marked as complete until all the questions have been completed, so starting early is key to finishing before the deadline. If your child needs any help, please encourage them to go to the Learning Bubble, speak to their teacher or send them an email.
