Year 11 GCSE Revision trip

Your child has successfully been allocated a place on the revision trip, it will be very supportive in preparation for their GCSE exams.

Any money outstanding should be paid via Parent Pay by Monday 2 October 2023.

We will be leaving school by minibus on Friday 6 October at 2.30pm, and expect to be returning back to school around 1.30 pm on Sunday 8 October. We will be based at an outdoor adventure site called High Adventure in Cowling, which is between Keighley and Skipton. During the trip I can be contactable on the school mobile on 07522408803, however we ask that this number is used in emergencies only.

Whilst the weekend will be intense, it will also be fun. Students will get some time to relax but the key focus of the few days will be intense revision. Students are expected to be prepared to work extremely hard and we expect the highest standards of behaviour from all our student. This will be a challenging weekend and our students are expected to show resilience. In the very unlikely event that any student fails to meet our expectations, we **will** have no option but to send them home.

On Friday Students **do NOT** need to attend school in their uniform, however they will be expected to bring along all their equipment with them which can be brought to school and safely stored between 7.30am and 7.50am in S10. Please see the recommended kit list below. Students will attend normal lessons periods 1-5. At the start of period 6 students will need to collect their belongings from S10 and then meet in the canteen for 2.25pm.

At the centre there is very little on site where you can spend money, so I'd suggest bringing no more than £10.

No electrical items other than phones are allowed, which will need to be handed in to staff at 'lights out' and returned to students before breakfast, this is to ensure that everyone gets a good night's sleep. We expect full attendance in school on Monday 9 October.

Kit list

What you will need:
